Questions in the present simple

To make questions with be, we put the verb before the subject.

Positive	Question	
I am late.	Am I late?	
She is coming for dinner.	Is she coming for dinner?	
We are going out.	Are you going out?	
They are eating.	Are they eating?	

If there is a question word (why, what, where, how, etc.), it goes before the verb.

Question word	Question with question word	
Are you late?	Why are you late?	
Is she coming for dinner?	When is she coming for dinner?	
Are you going out?	Where are you going?	
Are they eating?	What are they eating?	

For other verbs in the present simple, we use the auxiliary verb do/does in the question.

Positive	Question	Question with question word
You work at home.	Do you work at home?	Where do you work ?
It costs £10.	Does it cost £10?	How much does it cost ?
They go on holiday.	Do they go on holiday?	When do they go on holiday?
