never - I **never** look at Instagram - 0 times

always, usually, often, sometimes, every _____ (at the end of a sentence),

100% always

usually, normally, **generally, mainly**
often

50%

sometimes
rarely, seldom
hardly ever

0%

never

Present Continuous:

Form: Mark is writing on his computer **right now/at the moment**.

Subject + verb (to be) + verb + ing

When do we use:

- actions happening right now
- temporary action

When do we use the present simple:

- repeated action - habits and routines (use of adverbs of frequency - usually, always, every ___)
- truths and permanent situations
