

Ask another student:

If they have a bank account, what type and where.

Ask another student:

If they would be happy to live with less money and fewer possessions.

Ask another student:

If they won a million dollars, what they would do with the money (but they can't spend it on themselves or their family)

Ask another student:

If they agree that people judge you by your job and how much you earn.

Ask another student:

If they agree that money always makes people happy.

Ask another student:

If they have ever wasted money on something they have never used.

Ask another student:

If they have ever saved for a long time to buy something (and what it was).

Ask another student:

If they have ever borrowed money from someone in their family.

Ask another student:

If they have ever won any money (e.g. in a lottery or betting).

Ask another student:

Which they think is more important in a relationship – money or love.

Ask another student:

If they have ever been robbed or had anything stolen, and what happened.

Ask another student:

If they have bought anyone a present recently.

Ask another student:

If they have ever made an investment and what they invested in.

Which they think is more important – quality or price.
