## Main uses of modal verb "would":

1. Used as "would like" (=want) in polite requests or offers:

```
"I'd like to go home now please."
```

Can be used with other verbs to sound more polite:

```
"I (would) prefer...."
```

"I (would) recommend...."

2. Used as the past of "will" in reported speech:

```
Direct speech = "I will write to you"

Indirect speech = She said that she would write to me.
```

Direct speech = "Will you please do your homework?"

Indirect speech = The teacher asked us if we would do our homework.

3. Used in **hypothetical or imaginary situations**, or situations that are unlikely to happen:

<sup>&</sup>quot;We'd like to ask you a few questions."

<sup>&</sup>quot;Would you like some coffee?"

<sup>&</sup>quot;I (would) suggest...."

<sup>&</sup>quot;If I won 10 million crowns, I would buy a house."

<sup>&</sup>quot;What would you do if someone attacked you?"

<sup>&</sup>quot;It would be much better in Sweden if the sun shone all the time."

<sup>&</sup>quot;If I was/were a bird, I would fly around the world."
