- 1)I'm just pulling your leg.
 = I'm kidding.
- 2)He's completely off his head. = He's insane.
- 3)Don't be nosy!
 = You are showing an unhealthy
 interest in my business.
- 4)We don't see eye-to-eye.
 = We disagree.
- 5) She's (really) letting her hair down.

= She's having fun for a change.

- 6)He's had a change of heart. = He's decided to do something different.
- 7) I've got to get something off my chest.

= I have a problem I'd like to discuss.

- 8)She really put her foot in it. = She made a tactless mistake.
- 9)Let's play it by ear.
 = We can improvise.
- 10) It costs an arm and a leg.
 = It's very expensive.
